ACCEPTED: Aluminum and steel cans • white, mixed paper, junkmail • magazines and catalogs • newspaper • cardboard/paperboard • plastics bottles (#1s and #2s) • clear, brown, blue, and green glass bottles & jars, • clean plastic sacks

No styrofoam, wax boards, butter tubs, deli trays, etc.

Hours: Mon. – Sat. 8:00 am. to 4:00 pm.

ACCEPTED: Recyclables, scrap metal including washers, dryers, stoves, etc. NO Freon appliances. Non-recyclable trash *must* be dropped off in big orange bags. **Ask about our Orange Bag Program.**

The Hazardous Materials Facility

ACCEPTED: household hazardous materials including: • electronics • paint, • gasoline, • batteries, • fertilizers, • cleaners, • pesticides, • herbicides, • oil, • oil filters, • antifreeze, • Freon containing appliances • pool chemicals, and more. A fee may be charged for disposal of some paint and electronic items. Visit our **HazBin Room:** paint, cleaning supplies, auto fluids, lawn & garden chemicals, & more are available free of charge! Call for details: 349-2848.

Hours: Mon. – Sat. 8:00 am. to 4:00 pm.

To dispose of Freon-containing appliances:

purchase \$20 stickers from Central Recycling & Reuse, at either the Hazardous Materials Facility or the Administration Building. The fee pays for the Freon extraction. Freon appliances are items such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and dehumidifiers.

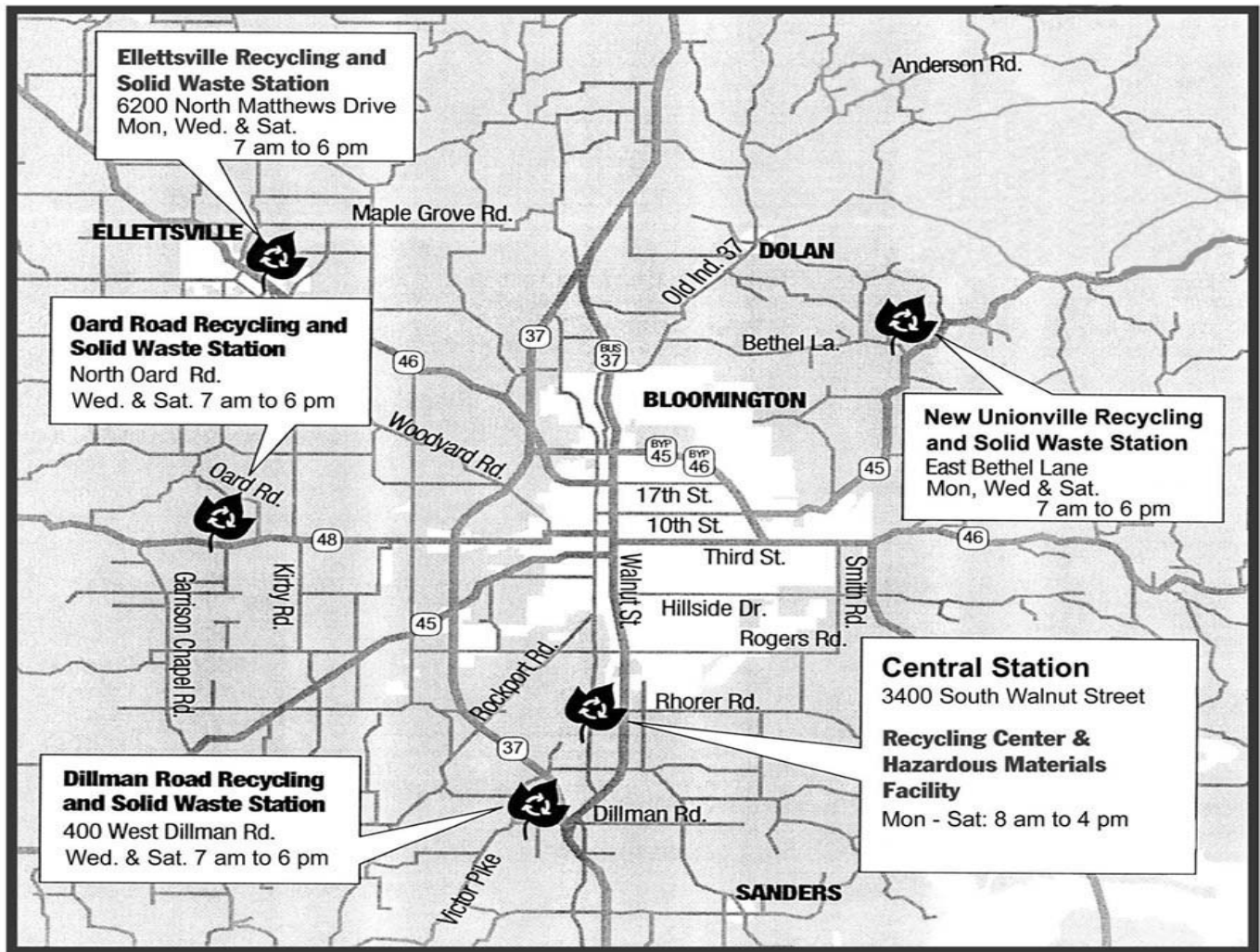
